#### **Anabaptist History Tour Details...**

This is an opportunity to study Anabaptist history with a study tour to Holland, Switzerland, and Germany. You will visit numerous sites where Anabaptists lived, hid, worshiped, were imprisoned, or died. There will be numerous museums and castles, You'll see the Swiss Alps and Dutch windmills, experience a canal boat tour through Amsterdam, visit a flower auction, and much more. Numerous native speakers and guides will contribute to this study tour directed by Myron & Mary Jantzi.

**Tour costs** include air and ground transportation from SMBI, lodging, morning and evening meals, three lunches, tips and taxes, and all sightseeing and attractions included in the itinerary. Lunch, snacks, evening beverages, and souvenirs are not included. Lodging is double occupancy in hotels and hostels. Quadoccupancy will be cheaper. Cost: approx. \$5300 per person depending on group size and airfare.

**To apply** visit the "student application forms" tab at smbi.org. A \$1000 deposit/person is due at the time of application. A second payment will be due Jan. 1, 2025 and the final payment due July 1, 2025. You may also email the office at smbi@smbi.org to request a more detailed itinerary or for additional questions or information.
