



# Summer Projects

Summer always brings opportunity for necessary upkeep and maintenance. The biggest project on schedule for 2025 is to add a 30 x 40 picnic pavilion to the campus facilities between the existing fire pit and the brick building by the ball field. We expect this to be heavily used during the summer months for family week and by rental groups. However, students will also enjoy it during nice weather. Expected cost is approx. \$25,000. Approx. \$17,000 in donations, labor, and materials, has been received for this project.

We also plan to upgrade the ladies dorm with new carpet, paint, and other updates. The right bedroom in the stage area will be updated at the same time. Approx. cost for these projects is \$9,000.

Before our assistant administrator moves into apartment 1, the vinyl flooring will be upgraded with vinyl planking. Approx. cost is \$3,000.


