These funds allowed us to complete over \$70,000 in facility maintenance and upgrades this summer. Included in that were the last four HVAC units in the main building. Opportunities!!!

In laying the foundations for SMBI, it was decided that we would "diligently avoid organized solicitations and fund raising projects." In this faith approach, God has generously provided. We do, however, periodically present specific opportunities. Following are a few of those.

<u>Recurring Donations</u>- See the note and QR code on the opposite page.

Student Aid- Regular discounts provided to teachers, mission staff, and pastors' along with specific student aid' were nearly \$13,000 last year. That is expected to approach \$20,000 this year. Contributing to the "Student Aid Fund" will help keep general funds available. Tractor fund- It was decided by the SMBI association to replace the old JD 322 garden tractor with a new Bad Boy 3026 compact tractor including a front-end loader, 6' scraper, and brush mower. This will be beneficial for campus maintenance and snow removal. Current designated donations are \$14,300. \$5,000 is needed to complete the purchase.

Riser fund- Our current choir risers were purchased in 1995. After 28 years and countless hours supporting the choir ministry, they are in need of replacement. Cost is \$7,000.
